

Your Skin... Stay Safe in the Sun



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Where, oh where has the sun gone? Lately, it's no where to be found! Now I know why the Aztecs worshipped their Sun God. When it's so cloudy out and it only rains, you'd think that the harsh rays of the sun wouldn't be able to harm the skin.

But, that is just not true. Even on a cloudy day, when you can't see the sun, the sun's rays are always present and attacking the skin. The radiation from the sun can cause the appearance of wrinkles, skin discolorations, dryness, flaky skin, immune system impairment, and skin cancer; besides cataracts, and other eye damage.

The only thing that can help your eyes is to wear sunglasses, when outdoors. Your skin must be protected with a sunscreen which is applied about 30 minutes before going outdoors.

There is one ingredient that must be present in your sunscreen for it to be effective: zinc oxide. An alternative to this is Avobenzone, which is the only chemical sunscreen currently allowed by the European Community, because it is considered safe to use. Arbonne happens to manufacture sunscreens with Avobenzone: Save Face and Body with an SPF 15 and Damage Control with an SPF 30. There are anti-aging ingredients in both of these products. Most people can safely use these sunscreens. People

who have moderate to severe acne, extremely sensitive skin, or skin conditions such as rosacea and eczema, might want to check with their dermatologist before using.
